All-Female Hamlet Colludes With Famed Super Sleuth

Silicon Valley Shakespeare presents Hamlet and New Sherlock Holmes Adventure in repertory

Friday evening, July 28, 2017, at 7:00p.m., Silicon Valley Shakespeare begins its 16th annual summer residence at Sanborn County Park in Saratoga with a clever twist on Shakespeare's classic revenge tragedy, *Hamlet*. Running in repertory with the Prince of Denmark is Jeffrey Hatcher's new, completely original *Sherlock Holmes and the Adventure of the Suicide Club*, which opens Friday, August 4th. Both productions run through Labor Day weekend.

The ladies take center stage as Silicon Valley Shakespeare's all-female cast of *Hamlet* illustrates the beautiful language of one of Shakespeare's most famous works, journeying into the mind of Hamlet and facing the ghosts that haunt him.
