Clever, Swashbuckling Romp Parries Up With Political Thriller

Silicon Valley Shakespeare presents The Three Musketeers and Julius Caesar in repertory

Friday evening, July 29, 2016, at 7:00p.m., Silicon Valley Shakespeare begins its 15th annual summer residence at Sanborn County Park in Saratoga with the political thriller, *Julius Caesar*. This classic Shakespeare tale of betrayal and power will run in repertory with Alexander Dumas' timeless swashbuckler, *The Three Musketeers*, which opens Friday, August 5th. Both productions run through Labor Day weekend.

Director Richard Farrell brings his experience working with the Oregon, Alabama, and Santa Cruz Shakespeare Festivals to the table as he sets *Julius Caesar* in a modern world, showing the power of the mob mentality, and addressing the timely question of how far people will go to rule a nation.

With 6 show credits on Broadway and 7 in London's West End, Ken Ludwig's adaptation of *The Three Musketeers* doesn't disappoint. It premiered in 2006 at the world famous Bristol Old Vic and received ecstatic reviews. Directed by SV Shakespeare's Executive Director, Doug Brook, this slick adaptation has everything you could possibly want in a play: adventure, comedy, romance, treachery, and scintillating sword fighting!
