Friday evening, July 27, 2018, at 7:00p.m., Silicon Valley Shakespeare begins its 17th annual summer residence at Sanborn County Park in Saratoga with a fresh look at everyone's favorite thief with a heart of gold, *The Hood of Sherwood*. Running in repertory with this legendary heroic outlaw is a 1920s stylized version of the Shakespeare classic, *Much Ado About Nothing*, which opens Friday, August 3rd.
